



## LES TERRASSES



**WINEMAKER**

**APPELLATION**

AOC Cahors

**REGION**

Cahors (Southwest) - France

**GRAPE VARIETAL**

85% Malbec et 15% Merlot

**TERROIR**

The grapes come from selected plots on alluvial Terraces, south oriented. The vines are between 30 and 40 years old with a density of 5,500 vines per hectare. The soil is made of pebbles, gravel and sand.

**CULTURE & VINIFICATION**

Sustainable methods are using in the vineyard. Mix of traditional vinification and thermovinifications. Maceration is shorter with an average of two weeks to preserve freshness.

**AGEING**

Stainless steel tanks for 6 to 8 months.

**TASTING NOTES**

Intense color with red fruits notes, this Cahors combines typicity and complexity of the Malbec with the roundness of Merlot. It opens up in the mouth with a well balanced structure and a long finish on ripe fruits.

**WHEN TO DRINK**

Now and up to 5 years

Alcohol: 12%
