### TERROIR

Located in the North part of the Rhone Valley, in the heart of the Saint-Joseph appellation. The 100-year-old vines are spread over 0.25 hectares (0.6 acres) of granite soil and are cultivated in accordance with sustainable agricultural methods (currently in transition to become certified organic).

### VINIFICATION

This cuvee is produced only for the greatest vintages.

Harvest: September 2015.

Aging: oak barrels (20% new) for 12 months.
