GRAPE VARIETIES

100% Merlot

TERROIR

The vineyard of Château de Malengin is spread over 20 hectares of ideal south facing slopes with sections of limestone rocks.

VINIFICATION

Particular attention is given to vineyard management in order to achieve low yield and quality grapes at optimum ripeness. Aged 12 months - 50% in amphoras, 30% in barriques, 20% in tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Eve is a faithful expression of the Rive-Droite terroir. This vintage succeeds in the double challenge of breaking the codes while honoring the values dear to the Rothschild family: audacity, excellence and transmission.

A new Bordeaux: crisp, clean, fruity and vibrant.

Pairs perfectly with grilled red meats, stews, and aged French cheeses.
