TERROIR

On the bank of the Loire River, the pebbly terrain called “La Caillote” is composed of clay, limestone, white soil “Terres Blanches”, and red earth “Terres Rouges.” The vines are an average age of 20 years old and yield 3.33 tons/acre (45 Hl/ha).

VITICULTURE & VINIFICATION

After the grapes are harvested, they are pressed and then undergo a 2-3 day cold maceration. Alcoholic fermentation then occurs in temperatures 68-77°F (20-25°C). Malolactic fermentation begins just after the alcoholic fermentation.

AGING

In enameled and stainless steel tanks for 5-6 months.

TASTING NOTES

This wine offers a brilliant red ruby hue. An intense nose featuring red berries, cherries, strawberries, and blackberries. A supple and soft mouth where red berry notes reappear along with a hint of licorice.

Delicious with white and red meats and cheeses.
